The Coalition is seeking 15 creative students who can take the initiative and enjoy working on a team project. You will develop and host a live-stream event to raise awareness about how to prevent human trafficking.

The event is scheduled for January 11, 2019, which is Human Trafficking Awareness Day.

- Students must be available from mid-December through January 11, 2019
- All in-person meetings take place in Whippany NJ
- This is a volunteer internship, but NJCAHT will provide lunches, partial travel reimbursement, and future letters of recommendation
- This internship is competitive: last year 105 individuals applied for 15 positions

MORE ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The 2019 Program will be to create a live-streamed event on January 11 - Human Trafficking Awareness Day.

Please DO NOT apply for this program if you can't attend the **5 mandatory** program dates below. One meeting is via Skype; 4 (four) meetings are in-person in Whippany, NJ.

- **Sat. Nov 17 @ 2pm to 3pm** = VIRTUAL Event Planning Meeting - (Skype/Google Hangout) - This 1 hour meeting will decide the focus of the Jan 11th event, and plan the event publicity.
- **Thurs. Dec 20 @ 10am-3pm** = IN PERSON ORIENTATION HT 101 / team photo & event planning.

Dec 21-Jan 4 = Collaborative work done by small teams in person/Skype or via email

- **Fri. Jan 4 @ 10am-3pm** = IN PERSON Team building exercises + further event planning

Jan 7-9 = Collaborative work done by small teams in person/Skype or via email

- **Thurs. Jan 10 @ 10am-3pm** = Event rehearsal and set up
- **Fri. Jan 11 @ 9am-2pm** = Human Trafficking Awareness Day Event (Live from 10:30am-12:00pm) + Intern Celebration

-- The Coalition will provide lunch for all in-person meetings, and will also provide partial travel reimbursement to those who complete the program.

-- This is a volunteer internship, but interns will receive a letter of recommendation from the Coalition.

-- Non-attendance on any of these dates will mean removal from the program.

1. **Why are you interested in this internship?**
2. **Describe your role in holding an event where you felt you made a significant contribution.**
3. **If you could change (or add to) one piece of content on our website - what would it be?**
4. **The 2019 Intern Program is to create an awareness day event lasting 90 minutes and being broadcast on Facebook Live on January 11th - what ideas do you have for this event? (E.g. theme, focus, promotion, how to make the event a success, your unique idea)**

NOTIFICATION OF FINAL INTERVIEWS = Friday, October 26, 2018

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PROGRAM = Friday, November 2, 2018
