Her first feature length documentary, “Opening Our Eyes” was a joint project with her daughter Erin Kelly. They circled the globe seeking ordinary people who are making our world a better place – one person at a time. Her latest film, “Like A Woman” is about women who are breaking barriers and working in male-dominated professions.
